An infrastructure dedicated to performance

- Dedicated busway of 7 km with 15 stations
- Commercial speed of 20 km/h
- 15 buses per hour in average (peak hours)
- Priority at crossroads (same roadsigns than the tram: R24 and three-coloured traffic lights)
- Tram-type roadsigns for drivers (traffic correlation and SAC (Driver Assistance System))
